

## CORRECTIONS FOR MILK MUSHROOMS OF NORTH AMERICA

Page 16: line 8 down, in line with, and just above *Lactarius vinaceosporus*, add the following  
*Lactarius maculatipes* (p.202), stalk scrobiculate; cap distinctly zonate, whitish to cream  
with pale yellow bands; spore deposit pinkish buff to yellowish; latex staining gills  
yellow.

Page 27: line 17, change milk white to milky white.

Page 31: immediately below line 8 down, add the following  
*Lactifluus allardii* (p.144), latex slowly becoming greenish olive then brownish, staining  
gills dull green to olive then slowly dull brown; taste acrid; cap pinkish cinnamon to  
dull brick red

Page 168: line 14 down, following Tennessee, add "south to Florida"

Page 176: line 16 down, delete unknown and add edible

Page 177: line 34 down, under gills, delete the comma after reddish to read "pale reddish  
cinnamon"

Page 178: last line down, remove the letter "a" from azonate to make "zonate"

Page 190: line 22 down, add "spores" following MICROSCOPIC CHARACTERS:

Page 202: line 15 up, delete "unchanging" and replace it with "changing to yellow within five  
minutes"

Page 202: line 15 up, after taste and before slowly, add "bitter then"

Page 202: line 17 up, after white, add "sometimes" and delete "slowly" after taste

Page 209: line 29 down, delete "Redhead and" leaving only A.H. Smith

Page 247: line 23 down, following glabrous, add "azonate,"

Page 292: line 35 down, following "fragilis var. rubidus," add 234
